Put your check in the RED box. Please sign up even if you are not purchasing lunch.

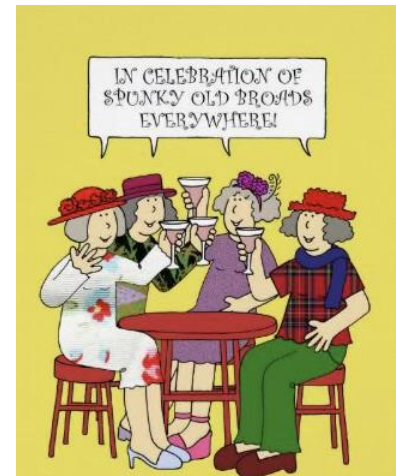
Be sure to bring lots of singles to buy raffle tickets! Immediately following the meeting, get ready to win raffle and attendance drawing prizes!

MENU:

1. Roasted Autumn Salad
Sweet potatoes, brussels sprouts, candied pecans, dried cranberries, grated Parmesan cheese, romaine, chicken and balsamic vinaigrette.
2. BBQ Ranch Salad
Corn, black beans, pic-de-gallo, avocado, tortilla strips, pepper Jack cheese, romaine, mixed greens, chicken and BBQ ranch dressing
3. Caprese Salad
Mozzarella, pico-de-gallo, croutons, romaine, mixed greens, chicken balsamic vinaigrette and basil pesto.
4. Cobb Salad
Hard-boiled egg, bacon, avocado, tomatoes, blue cheese crumbles, green onions, romaine, mixed greens, chicken and creamy blue cheese dressing.
5. Classic Caesar Salad
